## A u t h o r s ' r e s p o n s i b i l i t i e s

- ✓ To maintain accurate records of data associated with their submitted manuscript, and to supply or provide access to these data, on reasonable request, the author have to deposit data in a suitable repository or storage location, for sharing and further use by others;
- ✓ To confirm/assert that the manuscript as submitted is not under consideration or accepted for publication elsewhere, additionally, to provide the editor with a copy of any submitted manuscript that might contain overlapping or closely related content;
- ✓ To confirm that all the work in the submitted manuscript is original and to acknowledge and cite content reproduced from other sources, to obtain permission to reproduce any content from other sources;
- ✓ Authors should ensure that any studies involving human or animal subjects conform to national, local and institutional laws and requirements;
- ✓ To declare any potential conflicts of interest (real or apparent) that could be considered or viewed as exerting an undue influence on his / her duties at any stage during the publication process;
- ✓ To notify promptly the Journal editor or publisher if a significant error in their publication is identified. To cooperate with the editor and publisher to publish an erratum, addendum, corrigendum notice, or to retract the paper, where this is deemed necessary.

Authorship should be based only on:

- (1) substantial contributions to conception and design, or acquisition of data, or analysis and interpretation of data;
- (2) drafting the article or revising it critically for important intellectual content; and
- (3) final approval of the version to be published.

Conditions (1), (2), and (3) must all be met.
